

*The other Sons of Abraham are coming in! Here are some testimonies about the radio station. Thousands of calls have been flooding the station in Baghdad. After analyzing them, Pastor Feghaly forwarded these to us.*

1. many said, "Thank you for broadcasting the Gospel on your radio station. Now I can enjoy hearing the Word of God, Bible reading, and Christian music."
2. "My life was empty. I used to roam the streets until I found FM102.9. Now I can stay home and not feel lonely because FM102.9 comforts my heart."
3. "I am a Moslem who accepted Christ as my Savior. When my parents found out I am going to church, they punished me and forbade me. I was afraid not going to church is going to weaken my faith. One day I was flipping through the radio and suddenly I heard Christian music and the broadcaster saying, 'This is the New Testament Radio Broadcast'. I got so excited that I jumped with joy. I entered the privacy of my bedroom, turned the radio on and listened." (Several callers had similar testimonies.)
4. Many called thanking FM102.9 for giving them the small one-frequency radios, saying they don't care any more whether there is electricity at home or not because this radio is loud enough to hear anywhere.
5. Many callers asked FM102.9 to expand the broadcast until 12 midnight.
6. A large number of listeners called and thanked the radio station for the program "Teach Us How To Pray"
7. A large number of phone calls by people who are suffering from different sicknesses asking us to pray for them.
8. Many, many Moslems called our radio station suffering from marital problems and needing counseling.
9. A large number of new callers expressed excitement about expanding the broadcast to reach the whole city. Now anywhere in Baghdad people can hear and more and more are calling.
10. Many suffering from cancer have called requesting prayer.
11. One of the listeners called and shared this testimony:  
"I am a student at the University of Technology in Baghdad. As the result of some trouble in the University, an Iraqi Hummer came to deal with the problem. They were filled with Iraqi security forces. When the Iraqis came out of the Hummer we could hear Christian music and noticed the soldiers were listening to FM102.9 and all the students could hear the Christian music coming out of that Hummer. I was thrilled to find out they were listening."
12. A blind man used to spend the whole day roaming the streets. After expanding the broadcast to reach the whole city, he discovered the station. He called and said, "I no more roam the streets with board-em. I now sit home and enjoy the Christian radio broadcast."
13. A large number of listeners call us daily asking prayer for the political leaders in the government and for stability in Iraq.
14. When the 7 bombs exploded in front of the churches on Sunday, July 12th, many listeners called to make sure the station is OK and questioning the purpose of the terrorists and praying for the end of violence in Iraq and thanking us for broadcasting the Gospel.

In 2009, the government of Iraq allowed us to expand our radio broadcast to reach the whole city of Baghdad. FM102.9 today reaches 50 miles beyond the city. Eight million people have access to listen. An average of 1 million listen daily. It's wonderful that we are able to broadcast in English to reach American military bases.
